



Why ISB "Masked" Your Account Number in Online Banking

Internet banking is now more secure than ever.

On October 1, 2006, we started "**MASKING YOUR ACCOUNT NUMBER**" for all of your account types. Masking is the process of substituting a special character (*) for only the left-most account number digits. **Example:** *****1234

Displaying special characters instead of the account number reduces the amount of private information that might be compromised if viewed in a public place, such as a library or Internet cafe.

Create or Change Account Nicknames You can create, change or personalize account nicknames so it's easier to identify and manage your accounts.

Example: Vacation Club, Christmas Club, Household Account, Husband's Hunting Trip or how you refer to your accounts.

To create or change an account nickname:

1. On the **Accounts** page, click the **Options** menu and select **Change Nicknames**.
2. On the **Change Account Nicknames** page, select the checkbox for the account to be renamed.
3. Enter the account nickname in the text box.
4. Click the **Submit** button and the new nickname displays.
